One-on-one Intensive ABA Therapy



Our intensive and progressive Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) treatment is a specialized approach to education. It is a very active teaching and learning process that is driven by outcomes.

Teaching is individually tailored to each child and in the beginning stages rely heavily on one-on-one therapy. The focus includes communication, cognitive, play, social, self-help and other functional skills.

The number of direct intervention hours provided to a child is 30 hours or more per week.

Sessions are conducted 6 hours a day, Monday to Friday. Treatment duration typically lasts more than 2 years.

What does the program include?



One therapist to one child



Tailor-made curriculum according to the assessed need of the child



Learning via play and practice in different settings



Learning data and progress is recorded



Weekly supervision by Program Coordinators

Jumpstart Program



The Jumpstart Program is a 5-day (parents have the option to extend the time) intensive progressive Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) therapy conducted by our best staff and a Behavioral Consultant. This is a powerful opportunity for families to make rapid progress with their child in a short time frame. We will be able to identify critical learning areas, examine trouble areas and provide intensive focus to address these issues. Available in English or Mandarin.



1. Initial Assessment

AP provides a free consultation. Through personal meeting or over the phone, this is done to know more about the child's current development and needs. Parents can discuss with our Behavioral Consultant the program details, expectations and seek effective solutions.



2. Curricular Planning

Based on the child's skills and developmental needs, AP will develop goal-oriented curriculum and behavior plans with specific objectives and goals. Areas included are learning readiness, language, communication, play, social, cognition, behavior, and daily independence.



3. Ongoing Assessment

The Behavioral Consultant will observe the child's progress and will provide prompt assessment and analysis of the problems and areas of need. This will enable the parents to know the child's situation clearly.


- A** Families that are new to ABA and would like to experience what AP is able to achieve in a short time frame. This can enable better decisions about joining longer term under local services.

Model B Local staff
